



PRSC Golf Day 2016

The club's golf day at Barnwell Park, so well organised by Carl with many thanks, was held in perfect conditions on 17th July with the course in a very trim state.

Three very experienced and focused teams took on the challenge – the Festering Princesses (FP - Michelle, Pat, Brad, Michael), the Leagues Axis (LA - Bruce, George, Edward, Carl, Brian, Jackie, Barry), and the Resurgent Rogues (RR - Rob, Phil, Peter, PeterB) as per the below snapshots. Under the four ball best ball format all players contributed as relevant to their team's course planning, sledging, scoring, retribution, recrimination and acclamation.

As expected the golf was wild and woolly from start to finish, making a long harbour race in a black noreaster look controlled.

RR led off with a flushed drive and the standard was set until getting to the green where putting woes resulted in their only bogey of the day. FP followed and seemed to set their tone early, with all areas of the intended fairway and the two adjacent being aggressively examined. LA followed and it was great to see some six decades between the team – well done to all.

By the time RR were on the ninth tee it was obvious that more space needed to be gained in front of team FP who ramped up the aggression with drives from the seventh whistling overhead to the right – no matter that the seventh was a dog leg left.

The back nine further challenged and the final result was RR at -1 courtesy of a couple of drilled birdie putts after the line was shown with prior near misses, LA at +5 and FP at +6. As always, club camaraderie and golf were the winners.
